### **Reminders and Updates**

Please do your part to keep the laundry rooms clean. Maintenance does clean the floor but they are not responsible for wiping down the machines and picking up dropped garbage and lint.

If everyone takes a couple minutes to leave the room better than they found it we will all benefit. Just clean out the lint trap on the dryer, wipe down the machine if something is spilled or left a mess, and pick up dropped trash. It's also important to report any issues with the machines. To do that you need to contact the company that manages them, Coinmach. (PHA maintenance doesn't handle laundry issues.)

Here is how to do that:

You can either call Coinmach or submit a request online.

The number to call is: 877-264-6622

When you call you will need the ID of the machine that needs service. You can find this on a sticker on the front of the machine. It will look like this.



You will

also need this number if submitting a request online.

To submit a request online go to www.coinmach.com.

Look at the top of the page. You want to click on the box marked "Service Request".



On the service page you will need to enter the machine ID.

Once you do that and click on the "Locate" button you will be taken to a screen where you can enter information about the problem.

You will need to enter your name, phone number, and email address. Click "Submit request" and your request will be sent.

This is what the page looks like now:






There are a number of pages in our section of the site with things like a photo gallery, computer information, meeting minutes, and the Chit-Chat newsletter.
