Theater Program Information

The State, Pantages, And Orpheus Theater have many productions that free tickets are available for. You need to sign up for the Hennepin Theater Trust Access Participation program to be eligible to receive free tickets for shows. Free tickets include accessible seating.

The Guthrie Theater also has a program for nonprofit groups offering groups of tickets for \$2 each. (Individuals can get tickets for \$5 each.)

Most of the Hennepin Theater performances are at night. Guthrie performances have both evening and matinee options available.

All the theaters mentioned above are accessible by the Green line or by bus. (There is a short walk from the Green Line station.)

Getting tickets for dance programs and the Fringe Festival was discussed. (Tickets for the Russian Ballet were also mentioned.)

We were joined by Seal hi-rise OIR Officer G. He has a regular weekly hour in the community room and is starting a monthly social hour with residents. (It will be July 15th after the Stop For Me event.)

Issues with homeless people in hi-rises were discussed. Some sites are having problems with homeless people getting in/ being let in by residents and sleeping in stairwells/ trying to get into unlocked apartments.

Homeless people should be treated with compassion. They also shouldn't be allowed to wander around buildings where they don't live.
