Updates from Aaron

Aaron created a Google form for residents to submit computer issues. It will be added as a link on the PC website. It will be on the Citywide website as well.

Faronics

Our Faronics Cloud license will be expiring next year. (It was purchased in January of 2017.) The cost for renewal will be around \$14,000. Currently that is way over our budget. We need to decide if we want to stick with Faronics or should we look at other options. (Other options might include switching back to just Deepfreeze Standard or using a different program like Reboot Restore RX. Standard Deepfreeze would cost us over \$3000. The possibility of nonprofit rates hasn't been looked into yet. Reboot Restore RX would cost \$1250 on Techsoup. The version of Faronics we have is ours. We just won't get updates if we don't renew our licenses next year.

Computer rep updates

Seal had one of their computers stolen. (The theft has been reported to Management and the Police. The computer was locked down when it was taken. (The lock cable was cut.) Computers are working fine except for a bit of an issue after updating to Windows version 2004.

Management is considering closing the community rooms again. More information on this is forthcoming. Residents might be able to schedule a time to use the hi-rise computers.
