Computer Administrators Responsibilities

We need to recruit more Computer Administrators and Computer Peers. Recruiting new Admins will start next year. Councils should put up notices if they don't currently have an admin.

Multiple people from the same hi-rise can be Peers. There should be just one Admin per site though.

Starting next year Computer Admins will need to submit the cleaning log each month to get their stipend each month. (This just lets the Council know that the work has been performed each month.)

Computer Admins will have to submit a formal resignation as other officers do if they want to step down.

Attending the Computer Team meetings is required to get your stipend.
