Aaron's Updates:

Faronics cloud installs have begun with Central. All updates need to be installed and computers need to be defragged before the install. The Anniversary update needs to be installed as well. Try to get it done this weekend if possible. Hopefully Faronics Cloud will be on all computers by the end of this month. Print limit is set to five pages per session. That can be changed if a council wants a higher limit.

Ampwinoff is a timer program that Aaron will be installing as well. This will allow us to set a login time limit on the computers. The timers will be set for 1 HR 10 minutes. At the end of the time limit the computer will reboot. A flyer can be made up informing residents of the coming enforced time limits. This can also be brought up at the Presidents Council meeting. This should be brought up at Residents Council meetings as well. If a council doesn't want a time limit it isn't required to have one. (It is encouraged though.)

There will be training for Faronics cloud in the near future.

The modem purchase is still pending. That will be done when Julia gets back. The Presidents Council is purchasing these modems for the hi-rises. Hi-rises are not expected to pay anything for these.

Modems are needed because a number of hi-rises have modems that are at the end of life cycle. (Other hi-rises are renting from Comcast. Having their own modems will save each site \$15 a month or so.)

Questions and issues:

The Anniversary update should come as part of the regular Windows updates if you haven't installed it yet. If you have issues installing it that way you can download it directly from Microsoft.
