## **Computer Peer application**

The final version of the Peer application was handed out. It will be posted on the PC website soon.

The application has been approved by the Presidents Council and the Citywide Council.

The Peer stipends and invoice have been approved by the Executive Board. The proposals will now go to the Presidents Council for approval.

Presidents Council will pay the stipend for Computer Peers. Hi-rises will pay the stipend for Peer Computer Administrators.

Admin stipends would be once much they no matter how many trips to the site the admin had to make. Regular Peers get \$15 an hour with a half hour minimum.

## **Computer maintenance**
