PHA IT Updates

PHA IT director Joe Furst spoke.

He was at the meeting to talk a bit about the PHA IT department and answer questions. Turning off the computer and holding the power button for ten seconds or so will clear the motherboard cache.

A question was asked about updating Quickbooks. That is possible but the current Quickbooks versions require a subscription. There is no standalone version of Quickbooks Desktop anymore. You need a monthly subscription as well as paying for the software now. Important troubleshooting tips:

- Physical: Is everything plugged in? Is anything missing?
- Data link: Is there a blinking light on the wi-if card or adapter? Are the correct modem lights lit?
- Network: Is the computer connected to a wi-fi network? Is it the correct one? Are the correct lights on the modem and router lit?
