## **Visitors and Security**

hallways late at night, and physical altercations which occured with neighbors, police and guests.

Please be respectful of this building and it is home to a large and very diverse population!

If the security is an issue, please contact PHA management. Our neighbors have a right to feel safe in their own homes.

It's Jesus in a manger scene


And a candle with a yellow glow
